














This month started really crazy — with **All Fools' Day**. It was a great fun to come to the KG just in our pyjamas and to stay the whole day in these comfy outfits.



The "by the way" goals were to find out more about living things surrounding us and widen kids' vocabulary (e.g. cabbage butterfly, locust tree, black ground beetle...). This "spy mission" suited us pretty well, kids took it very seriously, or at least the competitive part ©. Nobody can, or would, want to stop the tomfoolery in nature in this beautiful weather.
