




















We've been with...






























None of this would be possible without our great teachers, though! They are the people who are our "pre-

We got a nice tip to go to Bibiana for a new exhibition "The World of Bibiana Wheels". If you haven't been there



I decided to be a teacher for sure when I turned 15 and applied for Pedagogical School, the journey of teaching started right there. I did not even thing about another job, perhaps a dressmaker, yet I listened to my

I love creating and designing my own educational goods, such as puppets, paper dolls, posters, worksheets and so on. I have the eager desire to form the little ones, to share important values, to educate them and to let them embrace their fantasy and imagination. Could I do all the things above in an office job? Well, I did try it for a little bit, and look at me, I am working here and enjoying it as much as I can.

Why Kindergarten?

Why do I work in the Kindergarten? It's simple. In kindergarten you can see how pure and honest the children are. Nowhere else, you can experience it. I do love the age of 3-6 when children observe the most and their brains work like a computer. It is incredible to watch the development of every child, how suddenly a child remembers new vocabulary and starts to use it the correct way and so on. Also, the teaching approach suits me well. Watching their minds when I start with a simple motivation with the use of a puppet is priceless. You can see through their eyes the eagerness and hunger to learn more and more. Every day is a special day. Simple hug, craft, little talk or a smile is enough to make it


Do you play at home?
