Regarding our education there are not that many changes in comparison to last year and we work on hard to keep the HIGH QUALITY of

FDUCATIONAL CONCEPT and **ACTIVITIES** in all the areas. We try to implement new challenges, new standards, new class innovations. We continue in providing sport activities including swimming, skating, skiing, tennis and even we are not the sport kindergarten, what is important to understand, we believe that development and support of gross motor skills is an important part of children complex development in general. Also this year we are happy to take an advantage of our Mrs Lenka's service in "speech therapy". She is already an integral part of our team core, a professional on her place. Last year we started with "extra clubs" for Y1 and Reception classes and we decided to continue with them also this year to extend children's specific skills. And yes, of course, we continue with our regular educational trips & events , too. Their aim is the direct experiential learning via all the channels and in interconnections. In case you have any opportunities and you think your idea can be interesting, don't hesitate to let us know:).

We continue on with FACILITY RECONSTRUCTIONS, enhancement and changes on both locations. On Gajova we already reconstructed the backyard, changed the floor in downstairs rooms, renewed the pavement in the garden . This year we plan to replace the windows in submarine and dinning room, we gradually reconstruct playground monkey bars and sand pit, we also plan to reconstruct the swimming pool. Most of the facility changes on Úprkova were done last year, so we gained new playground and gym. This year the school reconstructed the "pool area" to create an extra assembly place for different events and occasions, especially due to the rapid school and kindergarten growth. When talking about this topic, we also plan to build a new kindergarten on Bohunova street which would be separated from CIS building but an integral part of school area. This project counts also with small KG pool and gym as well as classes enrolling children from the age of 2. Of course, it is a long term project which should be finished by 2 or 3 year.
