In the beginning of January, we had a special visit — the very famous stand-up comedian and magician **Talostan** came for his show to our Kindergarten. He performed a few of his magic tricks with ropes, iron rings and scarves. Our kids were his assistants when he showed us how to make the scarf disappear or how to pull coins from an empty magic hat. Not only we saw many amazing tricks and illusions that blew our minds, but we also had so much laugh as

this magician is a very funny comedian. All the kids, and to be fair – also the teachers, laughed at the jokes. At the end, we got some nice presents for the class – cute animal balloons. Everybody enjoyed this event since it was full of jokes and magic.

WHAT DO YOU CONSIDER THE BIGGEST FASHION FAUX PAS?


Ms Ivetka: Those low hanging trousers where you can see the butt crack or underwear. And I don't understand holes in jeans, either.
