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

**Ms Sabina:** I would write a short book about differences between Polish and Slovak language in a funny way!



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### WE'VE BEEN BUSY WITH... WORLD OF SCIENCE



#### SCIENCE DAY

In connection with the topic "I Wonder Why", the teachers in all three campuses prepared amazing day full of experiments called Science Day! Children were excited and prepared to meet some famous and important men and women from the history: Galileo Galilei, Archimedes, Leonardo Da Vinci, Marie Curie, Isaac Newton, and many many more. In each checkpoint they got a chance to discuss different theories and hypotheses with these popular scientists. They even conducted some experiments. For example, Galileo explained them the law on conservation of energy and help them observe star constellations in the sky. Da Vinci discussed various art techniques and different ways of mixing colours, as well as properties of sound. Mr. Flemming explained how he had discovered penicillin and Mr. Newton talked about his laws of motion. It all might sound difficult but, in fact, it was just the opposite. These experiments were made in a funny way and the scientists were using toys, art stuff and some scrap material for their unusual activities. In the end, the children have learnt a lot of interesting facts and the gates to the world of science are wide open for them now.



#### PLANETARIUM IN OUR KINDERGARTEN

Perhaps one day, we will see our children among the most famous astronauts but before that happens, we let them discover the universe with its magical stars, planets, and other discovered or undiscovered secrets. Children got in, laid down, relaxed and watched the story about animals traveling through space. It was really great to get lost in the night sky.


**Ms Veve:** What do you call a magic dog? Labracadabror.



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
### EASTER BUNNY HUNT


