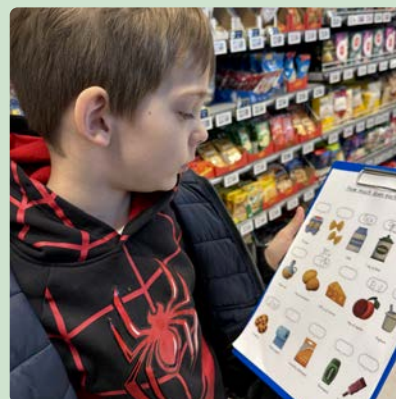

**Dávid (Shrimps MD):** Ja mám peniačky Spidermana.

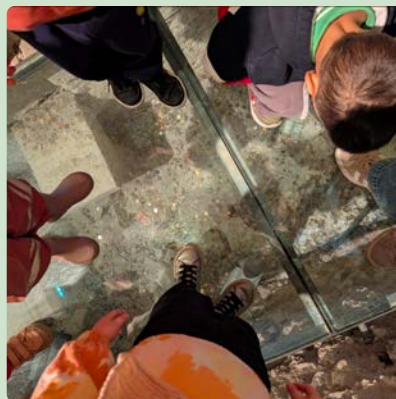
**Hectorko (Quokkas KOL):** My mummy and daddy go to shop and the shopper give them money.

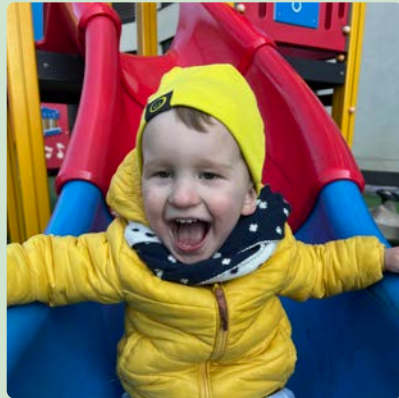
## SKATING COURSE
